The Parish Spotlight ~ Cemetery Care and Memorial Day

May 28, 2018 is Memorial Day, a U.S. federal holiday celebrated to honor the men and women who have died while serving in the military. The custom of honoring ancestors by cleaning cemeteries and decorating graves is an ancient and worldwide tradition. After the Civil War, America's need for a patriotic ceremony to honor its military dead became prominent, as monuments to fallen soldiers were erected and dedicated, and ceremonies centering on the decoration of soldiers' graves were held throughout the nation. But the specific origin of Memorial Day, or Decoration Day as it was first known, are unclear. In 1971, Memorial Day became a national holiday by an act of Congress and is now celebrated on the last Monday in May.

In keeping with this tradition, our Parish Cemeteries are cleared of the winter debris and last season's decorations and prepared for this year's celebration. The caretakers are responsible for the tasks of removing old decorations, mowing the grass and trimming around headstones. Not only do they prepare the cemetery for the Memorial Day holiday, but they are instrumental in keeping our cemetery looking beautiful long after the flowers have been planted and summer begins, which continues into the fall.

Special thanks to Terry and Lorraine Shadduck at Assumption Cemetery, where they have been the caretakers for more than five years, and to Mike and Dana Fye at St. Mary's Cemetery, who are the new caretakers this year. We also want to thank Bill Krajewski for the years he devoted as caretaker at St. Mary's Cemetery.

Every year a special cemetery Mass is celebrated on Memorial Day. This year Mass will be celebrated on Monday, May 28th at 9:00am at the Assumption Cemetery. Please bring your own chair. Light refreshments will be served. In case of inclement weather, mass will be celebrated in Assumption Church. Everyone is welcome.
