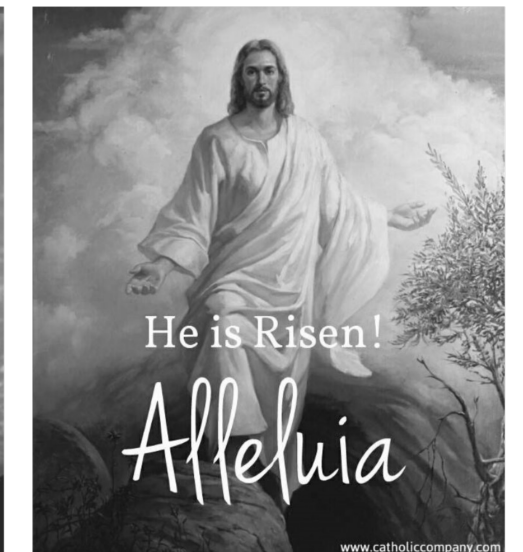
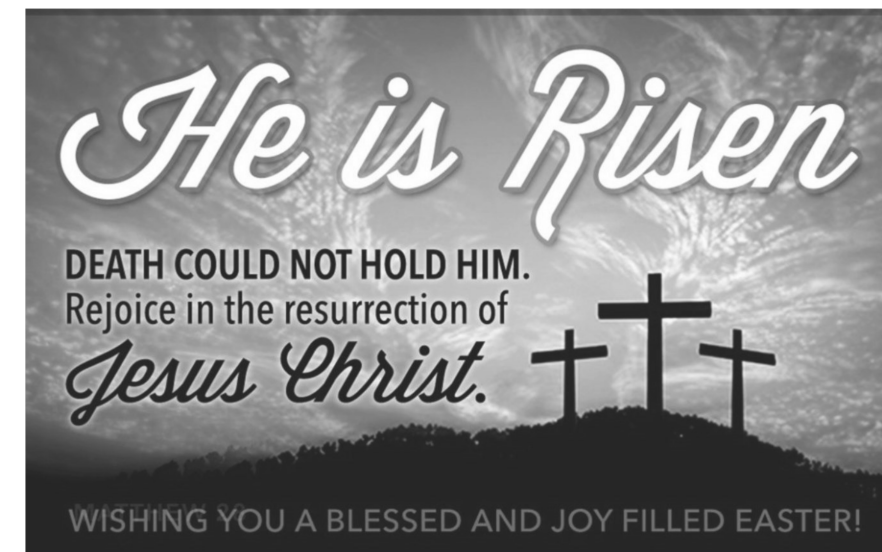

CUTTING THE GRASS AT ST. MARY'S CHURCH: I would like to thank David Miknis for cutting the grass at St. Mary's Parish this past year. In a true spirit of partnership, Dave, an Assumption Parishioner, offered to mow the grass. He also volunteers in the St. Mary's Bingo kitchen. I am pleased to announce that Deible's Lawn Service will be mowing the grass at the St. Mary's Rectory this year. They are also plowing the St. Mary's Parish parking lots during winter as well. 5 B's Landscaping will continue to mow the cemetery grass.

ST. MARY'S CEMETERY REGULATIONS: As we move into planting season, please be mindful of the new cemetery guidelines that were published last fall. If you do not follow the rules for planting, vigil lamps, etc. please note that the cemetery board will remove those items from your grave.

ASSUMPTION PARISH SEWER LINE WORK: We have just completed a major clean out of the sewer line which runs from Assumption Social Hall to the street. Much accumulated grease and waste was removed from the line. During fish fries we had tremendous problems with the sewer line. All that was required was a clean out of the line. Grass will be planted in the front lawn this spring. A grease trap will be installed in the social hall kitchen in late summer to ensure that this problem does not reoccur.

ONLINE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: We are making plans to complete this year's religious education sessions online. Resources are currently being pulled together, and communication links are being established among the catechists, and between the catechists and the parents. We hope to complete the religious education year by the end of May at the latest. Once work is sent out to students, they will need to verify completion of the work or be required by Fr. Bill to repeat the grade level. We hope to do 1st reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion in June. We will need to consult with DCC to see how their sacramental preparation is coming along before we can set a firm date.

LIFETEEN WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE STUDY: A great bible study for teens is linked to on our website. It can be found in the Religious Education tab, under "teens". The episodes are contained therein.

If you need to plan a funeral, call the funeral director of your choice, and they will begin the planning. If you call me to plan the funeral, I will refer you to the funeral director. They all have different procedures for how to conduct a funeral during the public health crisis.
