Parish Spotlight ~ Safety Committee

Under the guidance of Fr. Bill Barron, we have developed a Safety Committee composed of parishioners who are involved in our local Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services. I spoke with Ron Hannah regarding some of the changes that were made recently to provide better access for emergency personnel in the event of an emergency.

The committee did a complete walk through inspection of both parishes and social areas and comprised a list of possible obstacles that may be encountered by emergency personnel. Following this review of the properties, suggestions were made, and actions were taken to correct these areas of concern.

Some of the more obvious changes include creating Emergency Vehicle only areas convenient to the entrances of both churches to allow rapid response and ease of access without having to move vehicles to allow Emergency vehicles access to entrance areas. This has been completed and signs are posted.

Inside the churches some changes were made including moving votive candles in Reynoldsville to a tile floor and away from normal flow of the congregation to remove a potential fire hazard. It was also determined that the use of folding chairs placed in the aisles would not be allowed as they may block an emergency exit or become an obstacle in an emergency.

The committee worked together to identify which entrances/exits would be most feasible in the event of an emergency. The looked at steps, sidewalks, emergency lighting, etc. for potential hazards. The installation of additional smoke detectors and an AED device was completed. Some exiting procedures were altered for better flow of parishioners out of the buildings. There are people designated at both locations that have been instructed on what to do in the event of a variety of emergencies that may arise.

Thank you to the safety committee for their time, effort and for sharing their expertise in this matter.
