The Parish Spotlight ~ St. Mary Bingo ~ Barb Murray

BINGO!! This is the sound you hear every Sunday night if you attend bingo at St Mary's Church in Reynoldsville. Bingo starts every Sunday night at 6:05pm. Behind the counter, setting up cards for participants to play, you will find Barb Murray.

Barb Murray has been a big and active part of St Mary's bingo for the last 24 years! When Barb shared with me how long she'd been a part of St Mary's bingo, she also shared that bingo has been a big fund raiser for St Mary's church for the last 40 years, starting with Monsignor Mignot.

Twenty-four years ago, Msgr. Mignot asked Don Wojtaszek and Barb to help him out. At that time Barb shared: "we had an old machine and Msgr. called. Since then we have upgraded our machine." Don calls bingo, as do Sherry Carney and Billy Buskirk. We would also like to mention that we have floor workers, who help sell tickets, and our kitchen crews, who make and sell food to keep the bingo players well fed. "Many hands make light work".

Questions that Barb gets asked are: what is the bingo money used for? How does it benefit the church? Money made from bingo has been, and continues to be, used for many major projects at St Mary's parish. At one time, the King house was bought and torn down to make a much-needed parking lot. Then there was the Perry homestead, that was also purchased and torn down for further parking. There was also the nun's convent, a school, and the old rectory that were also torn down, and the church paid for the demolition in order to grown and renovate.

Furthermore, bingo funds helped eliminate all parents cost for religious education books, 4-5 air conditioning units were replaced over the years, and the same amount of furnace units replaced, as well as roof replacements and repairs. Food expenses from the Sunday dinners that our church used to host were paid by bingo, and St Mary's Rosary Society was given all the profit money from these dinners. There were bus trips to Pirates baseball games for the altar servers, where food and the Trailways buses were all paid for by bingo income.

Bingo has been and continues to be a large contribution to St Mary's parish budget. As mentioned above "Many hands make light work". We are always in need of help to make this possible. Right now, we are in great need of 2 more people to call bingo and at least one to two more crews for the kitchen. Please consider volunteering once a month. In addition to helping out our church, it is also a good way to fellowship with your parish family members.
