The Parish Spotlight ~ Vocations Crucifix ~ Gina Knarr

What is a vocation? If you are looking for a simple definition of a vocation, the literal meaning of the word is a "call." But a vocation is more than an ordinary call. A vocation is a call from God, and anyone who has felt God's call knows that the process is anything but simple. As a Parish Community, we can support those called and who are being called with our prayers!

Gina Knarr was introduced to the Elijah Cup ministry, while she was a parishioner at St. Michael's Church in DuBois and she was eager to help. She credits Fr. David Foradori with bringing this ministry to St. Michael's when a cup for vocations was given to him. They worked together to create a family friendly version of the 'Elijah Cup' so that children of all ages would be able to participate in praying with their family for vocations

Gina is now a member of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish and wanted to bring this ministry to life in our Partnered Parish Community. While discussing this program with Fr. Bill Barron, it was determined that the cup would be replaced with a Crucifix. The accompanying prayer journal was updated to include instructions and daily prayers, journaling pages to record their dated entry of any special thoughts, scripture passages, or additional prayers they may wish to share, along with pictures of our current Seminarians, and coloring pages for households with children. Coloring is another form of prayer, where the children can create a picture, and keep it in a prominent place in their home to remind their family to continue to pray for vocations.

The purpose of the Vocations Crucifix ministry is to encourage parishioners and families to pray and promote vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. We will pray for those who have answered God's call, pray for those who are in formation and to pray for who may be being called in a very special way to serve God. Praying is the most powerful way to support vocations!

During the season of Advent, we are asking all parishioners to prayerfully consider committing a week to this ministry. There are 3 Vocation Crucifixes available each week, one for each scheduled Mass. Then, beginning the weekend of December 29-30, 2018, these Crucifixes will be taken home for the week and returned the following weekend at the same Mass time in which it was received for the next parishioner or family to take home.

Each week at Mass, an assigned family is invited to take the crucifix home and put it in a place of honor. Then each day for a week, during prayer time (morning, bedtime or at meals), the family prays for an increase and perseverance of vocations. They can also send a note of support to a Seminarian, Priest or Sister. The following weekend the family returns the crucifix and journal for the next family to take home.

We encourage those who bring the Crucifix home to continue to pray daily for vocations and invite you to sign up several times throughout the year. Please sign up for one week at a time to allow everyone the opportunity to participate in the wonderful ministry.
