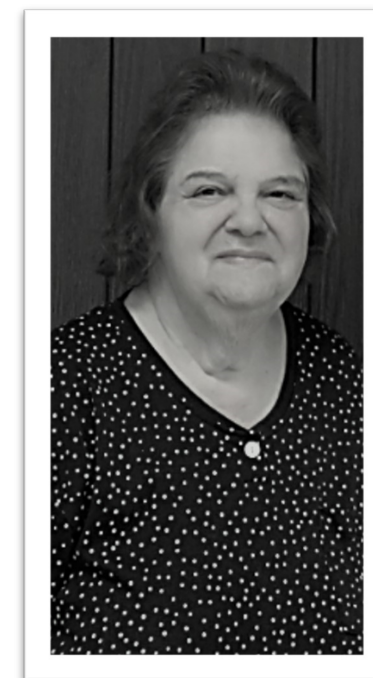

## The Parish Spotlight ~ Josephine Nichols, ABVM Altar Rosary Society



Josephine “Jo” Nichols has been a member of Assumption Parish for over 40 years! She serves the ABVM Altar Rosary Society as President. The Altar Rosary Society provides the items needed on the Altar for Mass and in other areas of the church as the need arises. The Zacchaeus Outreach group provides food baskets to the needy in our community for Thanksgiving, Christmas, and other times throughout the year when there is a need. The Lazarus Outreach group is available to prepare funeral dinners as a celebration of the life of deceased loved ones.

She coordinates of some major fundraising events in the Sykesville Parish. For well over 25 years, she has been overseeing the 30 or more volunteers who help with the Annual Lenten Fish Dinners. They serve on average 350 meals every Friday, for six weeks! That's a lot of fish! But there is more than just serving the dinners, from ordering serving supplies needed for eat in and take out meals to ingredients needed to prepare the delicious homemade recipes and ordering enough fish, shrimp, and potatoes to serve the crowd. Years of careful recordkeeping helps refresh the memory when it's time to prepare for the dinners.

The same attention is needed when October rolls around and it's time for preparation for the Fall Bazaar, held the first Thursday of October, and the Annual Turkey Dinner, held the third Sunday in October. She also coordinates hoagie and pie sales during the year. All these fundraisers provide funds to support the Parish and our community. When there isn't a fundraiser going on you will still find Jo helping in any way she can.
