The same attention is needed when October rolls around and it's time for preparation for the Fall Bazaar, held the first Thursday of October, and the Annual Turkey Dinner, held the third Sunday in October. She also coordinates hoagie and pie sales during the year. All these fundraisers provide funds to support the Parish and our community.
