## The Parish Spotlight ~ Holy Land Pilgrimage Update with Fr. Bill

Between the days of October 15th and October 26th, Father Bill, Father Solomon, and 20 other church members will be visiting Israel and Rome, leaving their everyday surroundings to be closer to God. A few of the places that will be visited on this pilgrimage include The Sea of Galilee, Bethlehem, Jerusalem, Mount Calvary, Sistine Chapel, Vatican Museum, and Rome. The trip will also consist of Walking the Way of the Cross and attending the Pope's audience at St. Peter's Square. This will be Father Bill's first time to Israel, and he stated: "You can go on the internet and get video tours of the places and see them, but at the same time there's no substitute for experiencing what these places are. This trip will help me to see the scriptures in a different way and the lives of the people in the scriptures." He also has hopes that the church members attending the pilgrimage will "find renewal in their own lives and see a new chapter in their spiritual lives open up."
