

# Parish Spotlight ~ Sacramental Preparation for Adults

Deacon Steve and I are beginning to work on sacramental preparation for adults. This is a very important part of the Church's work. We spend a lot of time (and justifiably so) on sacramental preparation for children and teens. But there are many adults who need to still receive sacraments. Sometimes, these people want to be baptized. Sometimes, they are already baptized but want to enter into the Catholic Church. Sometimes they simply missed a sacrament as a youth, such as first penance or first Holy Communion. Sometimes, they missed their Confirmation. Sometimes, they are married civilly, but not validly in the Church. They want to get married in the Church validly. We want to assist all these people in obtaining sacraments.

Frequently, we have people who are in need of starting an annulment petition. The annulment petition is usually started at the parish level. The Diocese of Erie has a church court (the marriage tribunal) where these petitions for marital annulment are sent to be judged. Every diocese has its own marriage tribunal. An annulment petition looks at the time of the wedding ceremony to judge whether or not there were any factors at the time of the wedding that prevented the marital parties from entering a valid Church marriage. Sometimes, the grounds for annulment is as simple as someone getting married at the magistrate, or at another church without a dispensation. Sometimes, one of the spouses misrepresented their intentions about marriage, essentially lying in their vows. Sometimes, one or both of the spouses lacked sufficient maturity to understand marriage.

If you need to receive a sacrament, or want to become Catholic, or you want to start an annulment petition, or get married in the Church, please call us. We are happy to help. First Sacraments are usually celebrated in the Easter season, so this is the last call for persons who want to celebrate them this spring.
