

## The Parish Spotlight ~ It's Turkey Dinner season again

When summer turns to fall, and cooler days are forecasted, it is the perfect time for a Turkey dinner! The first of two turkey dinner fundraisers will be held at the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish on Sunday, October 20, 2019, and the second turkey dinner will be held at St. Mary's Parish on Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

This year with be the 29<sup>th</sup> year for the dinner at Assumption Parish. It well be held from 11:30am until 2:00pm or until sold out.

Although this is a church fundraiser, the Rosary Society members are responsible for the planning and preparation. Josephine Nichols, Rosary Society President, has spearheaded this event for many years. While talking with Jo, she shared with me that this is no easy task given the time it takes leading up to the day of the dinner to prepare the turkeys and all the trimmings, as well as schedule volunteers to help with the preparation. There is quite a large group of volunteers that step up every year to assist in making this a very successful fundraiser for our parish. Jo says, "I am very thankful for the number of members who help with this event," we couldn't do this without the generosity of parish/rosary society members who donate their time to help in anyway.

With that being said, no dinner is complete without dessert, and thankfully we have a very supportive parish family who lovingly donate fresh baked apple and pumpkin pies to provide a delicious dessert to complete the meal. Along with the turkey dinner, there is a Cash Prize Giveaway with raffle tickets being sold by parishioners before the dinner and during the dinner as well. Proceeds from this fundraiser are used to help repair and maintain the church and rectory properties. Over the past 28 years we have served over 12,000 dinners and have raised more than \$65,000.

The St. Mary's Parish has been having their election day turkey dinner for approximately 36 years.

Much preparation goes into making this dinner a success, with many parishioners assisting over these 36 years. Planning and preparations start a month in advance of the dinner, and includes ordering the turkeys, side dishes and supplies. Then, volunteers help to cook and wrap the turkey, make the stuffing, and peel countless pounds of potatoes, not to mention chopping up the cabbage for coleslaw. Setting up the church hall is also a big job and over the years, many volunteers help set up the tables and chairs needed to serve those who come to partake of our dinner.

During the dinner, there is a Chinese auction, as well as the Rosary and Altar Society bake sale. Tickets for the Chinese auction baskets are sold at the dinner. There is also have a takeout section for those who wish to enjoy turkey dinner in the comfort of their own home.

The Sunday following the two-day turkey dinner St Mary's Church hosts a "Super Bingo," and any left-over turkey is made into hot turkey sandwiches and served at bingo with our regular menu. Individuals who are up for playing bingo and enjoying hot turkey sandwiches may also buy tickets to bid on our Chinese auction baskets.

Most importantly, no fundraiser is a success without the support of our parish family and community who come every year and enjoy our dinners. Thanks to all of you for your continued support.
