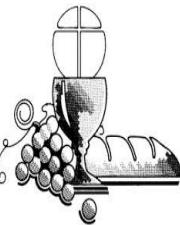
MARRIAGES

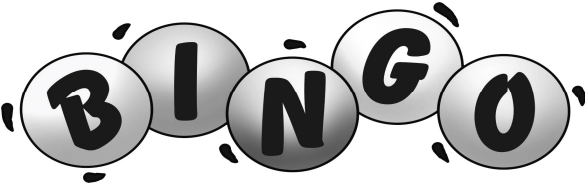
