

# The Parish Spotlight ~ Bob Thompson ~ ABVM Maintenance

Have you ever sat down and took a long, detailed look at our Church and wondered who takes care of the minor repairs needed for the upkeep of our property? At the Assumption Parish, that person is Bob Thompson. Bob was a Union Roofer who retired after more than 40 years of service. Along with the years of experience he brings from that job, he also enjoys working with wood and metal. When asked how and when he got involved in Maintenance for the church, he chuckled and said, "my Brother-in-Law Clifford (McAninch) would call me and ask me to give him a hand with a project he was working on." As time went by, he helped with more projects and when Clifford couldn't do it anymore he stepped up to provide these services for the Church.

Bob finds the greatest joy comes from preparing for the Fish Dinners. He enjoys cooking the fish every Friday night. He also helps in the preparation of the food and keeping the kitchen area clean. While reminiscing about projects he has worked on for the kitchen, he shared one particularly interesting story of how it would take three to four people to cut the cabbage to make Haluski as some of the heads of cabbage were often quite large and dense and would be very difficult to cut. That is when he designed our current cabbage cutter from an old machete handle, some butcher block, and a piece of stainless steel. He fabricated the steel into a large blade and sharpened it, attached it to the old machete handle and mounted it on the butcher block to create a tool that provides more leverage to cut the larger heads and has lighten the work load so now one person can cut all the cabbage needed. He also fabricated drawers to provide storage underneath the butcher block table to allow better access to tools needed when preparing for our dinners.

Bob has been working behind the scenes for over 15 years doing a variety of jobs to keep the Parish property looking good and working well. From the smallest of jobs, such as cleaning and maintaining equipment used around the church, to taking care of seasonal jobs at the rectory, such as installing air conditioners and moving lawn furniture, to larger jobs, like cleaning and scrubbing the floors in the Social Hall kitchen after major events. You will find Bob helping in any way he can to keep things running in tip top shape. He sees things that need done and does what he can to get them fixed and working again.

Please join me in thanking Bob for all the time and effort he puts into the upkeep of our Church and Rectory.
