From the Pastor's Desk

I know that there is a lot of concern right now, a lot of uncertainty. It is never good in such moments to make drastic changes to your habits. Stay the course on your church attendance, your sacrificial giving, your volunteerism, and your spiritual life. The normal business practices of the parishes continue as usual. Mass and Confession schedules continue as usual. Parish staffing continues as usual. Are there changes coming? Certainly. But consider that those who will make the necessary changes in the future aren't certain what those changes will be yet. Things are being worked out at present. Be patient. God has something good planned for those who practice patience.

My ordination classmate Fr. Justin Pino was thoughtful in coming to Sykesville on June 8th to concelebrate the daily Mass with me. The occasion was our 15th anniversary of our ordination to the Priesthood. On June 8, 2007, at St. Peter Cathedral in Erie, Fr. Pino and I were ordained priests by Bishop Trautman. At that time, I publicly knelt down in front of Bishop Trautman, and put my hands into his hands. He asked me "Do you promise respect and obedience to me and to my successors?" I answered, "I do". He replied, "May God, who has begun the good work in you, bring it to fulfillment".

As announced at the beginning of this month, I am being transferred to a cluster of 3 parishes near Morrisdale. This is a sad thing, as I do not like taking leave of people. At these times, I am reminded that the only reason why I came here in the first place was because the Bishop sent me here. It was because of my promise of obedience that I was blessed to be your pastor for these 5 years, and it is because of that same promise that I am now taking leave of you. Just as it was important for me to leave Emlenton to come here in 2017, so it is important that I leave here in 2022 to go to Morrisdale, Hawk Run, and Osceola Mills.

God has good things planned for us when we trust Him. These gifts sometimes come in surprising packages. But they are gifts nonetheless. Yes, it is hard to see how losing a resident pastor is a good thing. Indeed, there are a lot of things going on that look very bad, whether that be in the church or in the world. But God is going to get this to the good for you. You can take that promise to the bank. God has given us a lot of consolations, and God can turn even our desolations into something good. But you need to be patient and trust in Him.
