The Parish Spotlight ~ St. Mary's Turkey Dinner ~ Barb Murray

Every year, on election day in November, St Mary's Church has a two-day turkey dinner. This dinner has been a success and has been going on for approximately 35 years. Monsignor Mignot started this popular tradition and it has taken root. According to Barb Murray, one year they served 1537 turkey dinners!

Much preparation goes into making our dinner a success, with many parishioners assisting over these 35 years. Planning and preparations start a month in advance of the dinner, and includes ordering the turkeys, side dishes and supplies. Then, volunteers help to cook and wrap the turkey, make the stuffing, and peel countless pounds of potatoes, not to mention chopping up the cabbage for coleslaw. Setting up the church hall is also a big job and over the years, many volunteers help set up the tables and chairs needed to serve those who come to partake of our dinner.

Once all the preparations are complete, the volunteers help to serve the dinner and drinks, as well as help out with whatever else is needed. At the end of the first night, there is a clean up and tables are set fresh and new for dinners to be served the second evening.

During the dinner, there is a Chinese auction, as well as our Rosary and Altar Society bake sale. Tickets for the Chinese auction baskets are sold at the dinner. We also have a takeout section for those who wish to enjoy turkey dinner in the comfort of their own home.

The Sunday following the two-day turkey dinner our church hosts a "Super Bingo," and any left-over turkey is made into hot turkey sandwiches and is served at bingo with our regular menu. Individuals who are up for playing bingo and enjoying hot turkey sandwiches may also buy tickets to bid on our Chinese auction baskets.

This year, the turkey dinner will be held on Tuesday, November 6th and Wednesday, November 7th. In talking with Mike Fye, 1,200 dinners are being prepared for this year. Mike shared that it is a "great team effort from ordering the food until the last clean-up is done." Please come out and help support our turkey dinner. Also, help is needed preparing the dinner, setting up for the dinner, cleaning up from the dinner, or maybe you could assist by baking something for the bake sale. Any help is so appreciated.
