The Parish Spotlight ~ Emmaus Priest Convocation at St. Vincent's

I had the privilege of speaking to Father Bill recently about his upcoming trip to Emmaus, which will be held at St. Vincent's College in Latrobe, PA, at the Basilica at St. Vincent's Arch Abbey.

Father Bill will be attending this trip from Monday June 18th, after morning mass until Thursday June 21st. Father Bill shared that Emmaus was founded by Bishop Michael Murphy in 1983. Bishop Murphy felt that an annual convocation for all priests in the diocese was needed, to give our priests an opportunity to continue their education and spiritual formation.

Father Bill also shared that Emmaus was initially started at Gannon University. It moved to Christ the King Seminary in Buffalo for approximately 20 years, and then, as of 2004, has been held at St. Vincent's – (coincidentally St. Vincent's is where Father Bill went to seminary). An average of 75 priests attend this week-long Emmaus. Father Bill went on to share that the first part of the week is for the priests of our diocese and the latter part of the week is for the deacons of our diocese.

When asked what the week schedule looks like for Father Bill, he stated that "there is generally a mass to start and there are Mass Anniversaries shared with milestones of 25 years, 30 years and so on that are celebrated. Then there is a cocktail hour to socialize with fellow priests and following that there is a very nice dinner celebrating this." The dinner is held at The Fred Rogers Center on Monastery Road in Latrobe. As a side note, Father Bill shared that Fred Rogers was a Presbyterian minister who was born in Latrobe and is buried there today. As mentioned above, the week will consist of mass, opportunities to share and pray together with fellow priests, sharing Adoration, Holy Hour, fellowship over a sharing of meals together.

There is also a speaker that comes to discuss various topics in an opportunity to pull the priests together to promote being "co-workers" with each other and the Bishop. Father Bill stated that "sometimes being that our diocese covers a vast area you can feel that you are out here on your own" (so to speak) but Emmaus reminds us that we aren't alone as continue our journey together.
