Parish Spotlight—2021 ABVM Golf Tournament

The ABVM Golf Tournament began in 2005, when the need to make repairs to our stained-glass windows and other areas in the church was discovered. When faced with the need, Father Mark Mastrian turned to something he loves: Golf. He, along with a newly formed golf committee, went to work to start what is now the Annual Golf Tournament for Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish. Elaine Fike has been part of the committee since its inception and continues to dedicate much of her time to the behind the scenes work of planning for this annual event.

Our 2020 tournament, which would have been our 15th annual was cancelled due to COVID but this year we are going to be able to have a normal Golf Tournament there will be NO Restrictions!! Our 15th annual tournament will be held at Silverwoods Golf Course at Treasure Lake, DuBois on Sunday, July 25, 2021. The cost to golf is \$65 per golfer and includes greens fees, cart, lunch, dinner, and prizes.

There are a variety of things that need attention when preparing for the golf tournament. It begins early in the spring with scheduling golf committee meetings, coordinating schedules and amenities at the Treasure Lake Silver Woods Course, sending letters to our generous area businesses asking them to support our fundraiser by sponsoring a hole for the day of the tournament, and preparing the letter for our bulletin giving our Parish Family the opportunity to sponsor a hole in memory or in honor of their loved ones.

With the generous support of the ABVM Rosary Society, led by Josephine Nichols, the task of creating the lunch and dinner menu is completed. The Rosary Society prepares the food, at no additional cost, for the dinner meal for the golfers. The golf committee and volunteers arrange for the food to be delivered, set up, and served.

Our committee and volunteers are crucial for the success of the golf tournament. They go out into our community to collect door prizes, food donations and sponsorships. The day of the tournament they help with registration, selling raffle and 50/50 tickets, working the prize holes during the event, setting up, preparing Hot Dogs and Sloppy Joes for lunch, serving the meals, and cleaning up when the day has ended.

The success of our tournament ultimately relies on the generosity and participation of our golfers, who set aside this day every summer to support our Parish and to them we are eternally grateful.
