## Parish Spotlight—2021 ABVM Golf Tournament

The ABVM Golf Tournament began in 2005, when the need to make repairs to our stained-glass windows and other areas in the church was discovered. When faced with the need, Father Mark Mastrian turned to something he loves: Golf. He, along with a newly formed golf committee, went to work to start what is now the Annual Golf Tournament for Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish. Elaine Fike has been part of the committee since its inception and continues to dedicate much of her time to the behind the scenes work of planning for this annual event.

Our 2020 tournament, which would have been our 15th annual was cancelled due to COVID but this year we are going to be able to have a normal Golf Tournament there will be NO Restrictions!! The day of the tournament they help with registration, selling raffle and 50/50 tickets, working the prize holes during the event, setting up, preparing Hot Dogs and Sloppy Joes for lunch, serving the meals, and cleaning up when the day has ended.
