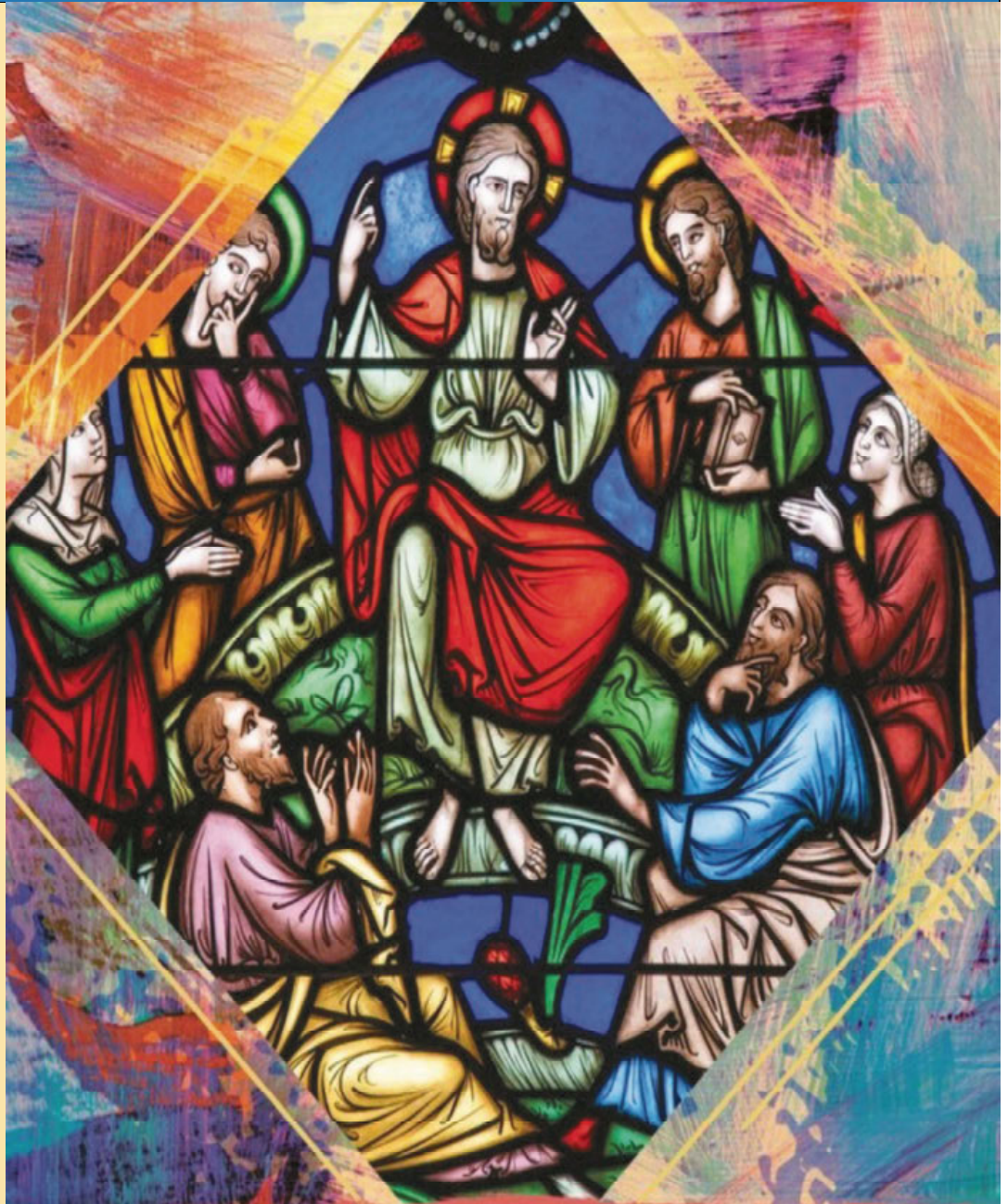

GOD CALLS US IN THE MIDST OF ORDINARY THINGS.
