### **GECAC Farmers Market Nutrition Program**

GECAC, through the PA Department of Agriculture's Farmer's Market Nutrition Program, will again make available \$20.00 vouchers for the purchase of fruits or vegetables that are grown in PA from our area farmer's market stands.

To be eligible, a senior must be an Erie County resident, 60 years of age or older in 2019, and meet the following 2019 income guidelines:

1 person \$23,107 or less 2 people \$31,284 or less
