

JUST SAYING -

First Sunday of Advent

Traditionally, Advent wreaths are constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Avent. Ideally, three candles are purple and one is rose, but white candles can also be used.

The purple candles in particular symbolize the prayer, penance, and preparatory sacrifices and goods works undertaken at this time. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday. Gaudete Sunday, when the priest also wears rose vestments at Mass; Gaudete Sunday is the Sunday of rejoicing, because the faithful have arrived at the midpoint of Advent, when their preparation is now half over and they are close to Christmas.

The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead.

The use of the Advent Wreath is a traditional practice which has found its place in the Church as well as in the home. The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the First Sunday of Advent or the evening before the First Sunday of Advent.

When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another member of the family.

A Family Perspective

At this time of the year we are very conscious of our family as we make preparations for Christmas. To-day's gospel warns us not to be consumed by all the consumer activity. This Advent appreciate the gift of people in your life. The best gift this season might be your appreciation of others.

As Our Neighbors' Place, the overflow shelter for homeless persons in Erie, enters its seventh year of ministry, we find ourselves needing additional help from the Christian Community for this winter season. Unfortunately, a few churches have found it necessary to drop out of the schedule and after shortening the shelter season by two weeks, we still find ourselves with a gap from December 5th through December 18th. Holy Trinity Lutheran Church has graciously opened their facility for us these weeks, but we still need to staff the shelter and provide dinner for this time.

Ideally, we're asking your parish to provide a night of ministry during the week of December 12 – 18. This would include providing a simple supper for 55 shelter guests

which is served at 8:00 pm, a few people to serve the supper, and volunteers to help staff the shelter for the night. Four volunteers are needed from 7:00- 11:00 pm, two volunteers from 11:00 pm- 3:00 am, and three volunteers from 3:00 – 7:00 am. Additionally, we ask that one volunteer on each shift be a woman. If you are unable to provide a full night of ministry but can provide a meal or volunteers for a variety of nights, that would also be helpful.



Deacon Tom and Pam have scheduled Friday, December 14, as an evening to assist in this ministry.

Father Greg and a few parishioners have agreed to join us in providing dinner and staffing the shelter from 7:00 to 11:00.
