From Bishop Persico


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
Latin America is home to millions of faithful Catholics. However, due to circumstances of distance, terrain, political instability and lack of resources, it is often very difficult for the people to practice their faith. In fact, in some rural areas of Mexico, priests and catechists are only able to visit the villages twice a year. Many of these communities lack books and religious materials, while others do not even have a church or education center. **The annual collection for the Church in Latin America (CLA)** allows us to help. For example, thousands of people living in the Amazon jungle of Ecuador can grow in their Catholic faith through materials now published in their native language. The CLA collection has helped to produce and distribute prayer and catechetical books. It has helped to fund Catholic radio programs which are now broadcast over a wide territory. Your contributions in previous years have made a real difference in sharing our Catholic faith with others. Today I ask you to renew your support for our brothers and sisters in Latin America. **I invite you to pray for them, and to support this year's collection for the Church in Latin America, which will be taken up on the weekend of August 18-19.** Together we can make a concrete difference in the lives of our fellow Catholics throughout Central and South America. Please know my gratitude for your generosity. Be assured of my prayers.

JUST SAYING -

THE CATHOLIC VERSION OF THE LORD'S PRAYER...WHY IS IT SHORTER THAN THE OTHER VERSIONS?



The **Catholic** version of the "Our Father" prayer does not contain the "Doxology". There are good biblical reasons for the omission of this doxology from New English and other popular versions of the prayer:-

*"For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours.
Now and forever. Amen"* (New English Version)

Common bible versions, such as the New International Version, and the Contemporary English Version, exclude the doxology from the Lord's Prayer in the main body of the text (in Matthew 6:9-13), and instead feature it as a footnote on the page. Critical editions of the New Testament used by the **United Bible Societies** (an organization representing 145 national bible societies) concur that this doxology does not belong to the original manuscripts of Matthew's gospel, and seems to have been added at a later date.

In 1963, the Second Vatican Council decreed a revision of the liturgy (undertaken by the ICEL, International Commission on English in the Liturgy). In 1969, the doxology was added to the **Catholic Mass**, not as part of the "Our Father", but following shortly afterwards. In the Mass, the Lord's Prayer is spoken together, followed by the Priest praying:

"Deliver us, Lord, from every evil, and grant us peace in our day. In your mercy keep us free from sin and protect us from all anxiety as we wait in joyful hope for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ."
and then the doxology (*"For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever"*) is prayed by the congregation.

This section of the mass falls just before the sharing of the peace, where the priest wishes the congregation the peace of Christ with the words *"The peace of the Lord be with you always"* and all who are present share God's peace by shaking hands or embracing each other (depending on the customs of the church).
