JUST SAYING -

***Every life has good and trouble —
or to use the terms of Luke 6,
blessings and woes.***

Each day has some of both. A card of encouragement and a hospital bill come in the same mail box: blessing and woe. A perfectly baked potato and an overdone steak are served as part of the same meal: blessing and woe. Everyone enjoys the blessings of the day and seeks to avoid the woes — so we give thanks for notes and potatoes and we appeal bills and send back steaks.

But these daily blessings and woes are not ultimate; they are simply a foretaste of what is to come. In contrast, there are blessings and there are woes that are ultimate and final. They will come when one leaves this life.

The wise man is the one who seeks the blessings that are ultimate and does not concern himself with the woes that are temporary.

This is the message of the beatitudes given by Christ in Luke 6.
