A Family Perspective

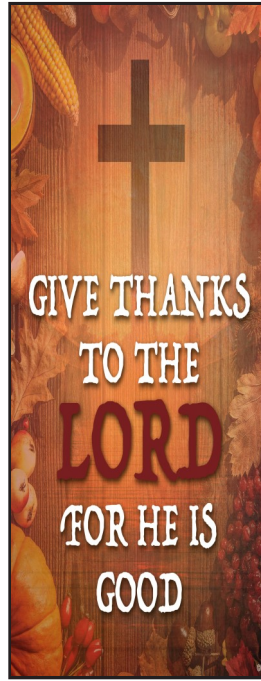
