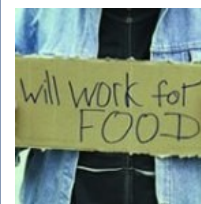

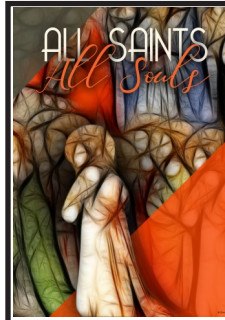
ALL SAINTS' DAY
