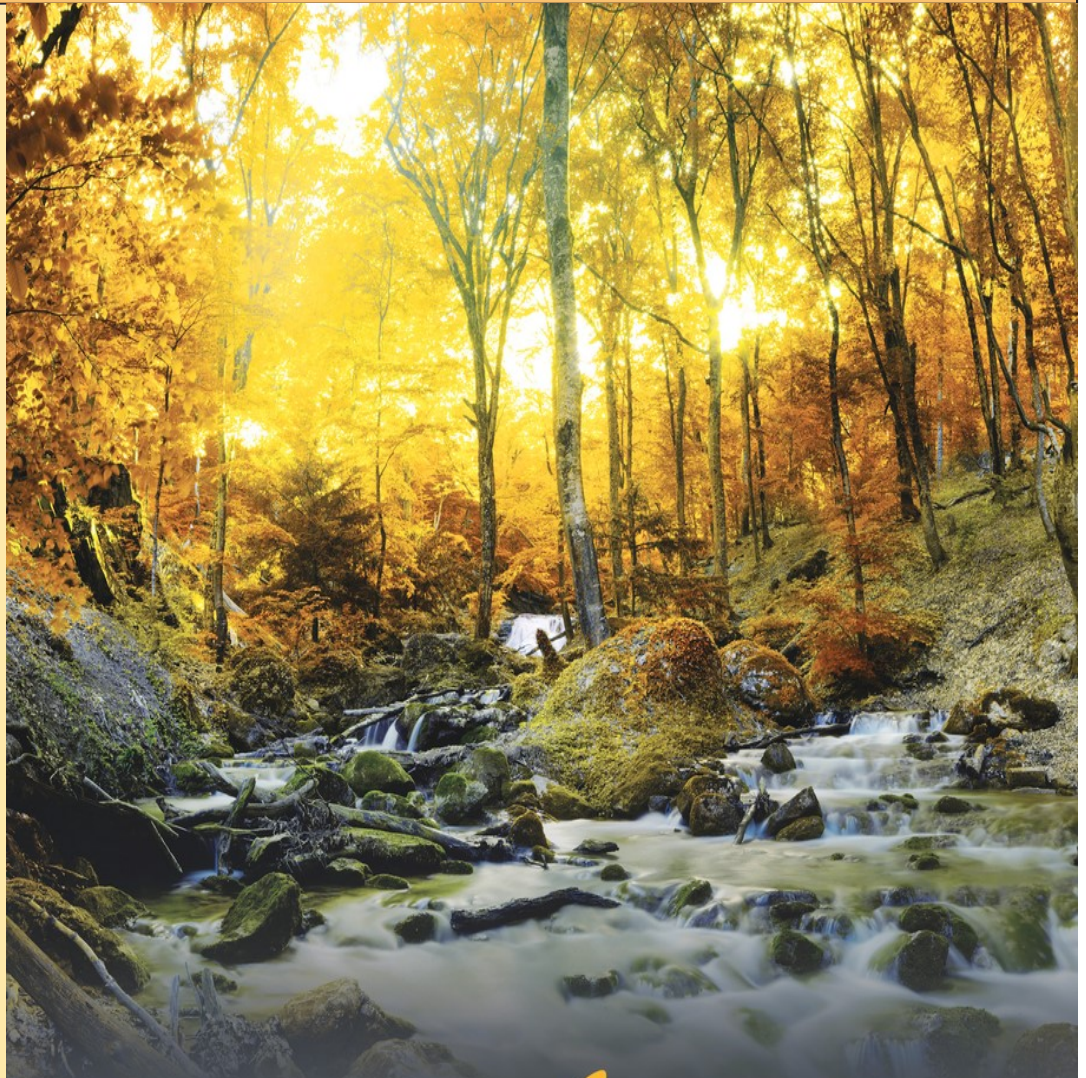

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

**On the weekend of November 21-22, a second collection will be taken up in our parishes for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD).**

As you may know, CCHD is the national anti-poverty program of the U.S. Catholic Bishops, working to break the cycle of poverty by helping people with low income participate in decisions that affect their lives, families, and communities. Half of the funds from this collection remain in the Diocese of Erie to help organizations such as Maria House Project, Erie Dawn, and Inter-Church Ministries fight poverty in our local communities. CCHD is a manifestation of our call to a discipleship that fosters a "solidarity which 'would allow all peoples to become the artisans of their destiny'" (Evangelii Gaudium, no.190). At a time when so many of our sisters and brothers are experiencing the devastating impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, the important work of CCHD cannot be underestimated. This work is not possible without the support of dedicated Catholics like you. Your contributions are helping to build more merciful and just communities in the Diocese of Erie and throughout the country. Please consider helping us to uphold human dignity and alleviate poverty by giving generously to the second collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.
