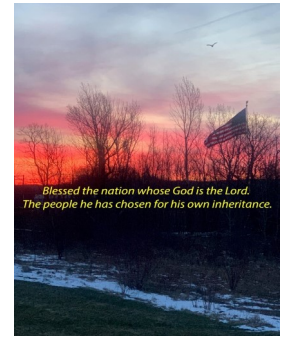

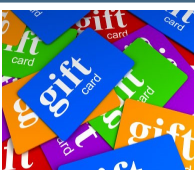

## From Bishop Persico—Next week's second collection for The Church in Latin America

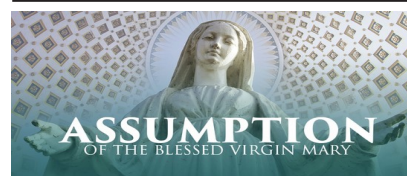
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

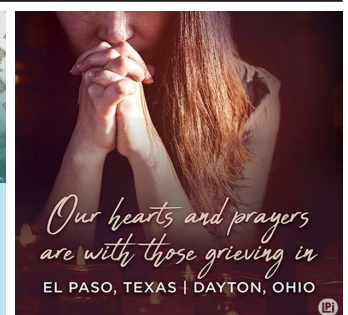
