JUST SAYING -

**Forgiveness is unlocking the door
to set someone free
and realizing you, yourself
were the prisoner**

*The first reading shows us that vengeance
comes from God, not from us.*

*The second reading tells that humility
belongs to the character of Christ.*

*The Gospel reveals that forgiveness is not an option
for the Christian. It is a requirement that we extend
to others as God has extended it to us.*

***This week, approach a family member, friend, co-worker,
or neighbor against whom you hold a grudge, and ask them
to forgive you. Holding on to resentment, bitterness or
unforgiveness towards them is what you ask in forgiveness.
Remember, through forgiveness comes healing.***

The Jewish sage Sirach warns of the dangers of wrath, anger, and vengeance, urging rather forgiveness and pardon. How do you see this as the recipe for peace of mind?

SECOND READING RM 14:7-9

Paul urges Christians in Rome to "live and die for Christ." How do you make Christ the ultimate concern in life?

GOSPEL READING MT 18:21-35

The parable of the unforgiving servant teaches us the forgiveness out to be reciprocal. What does this tell us about divine justice?
