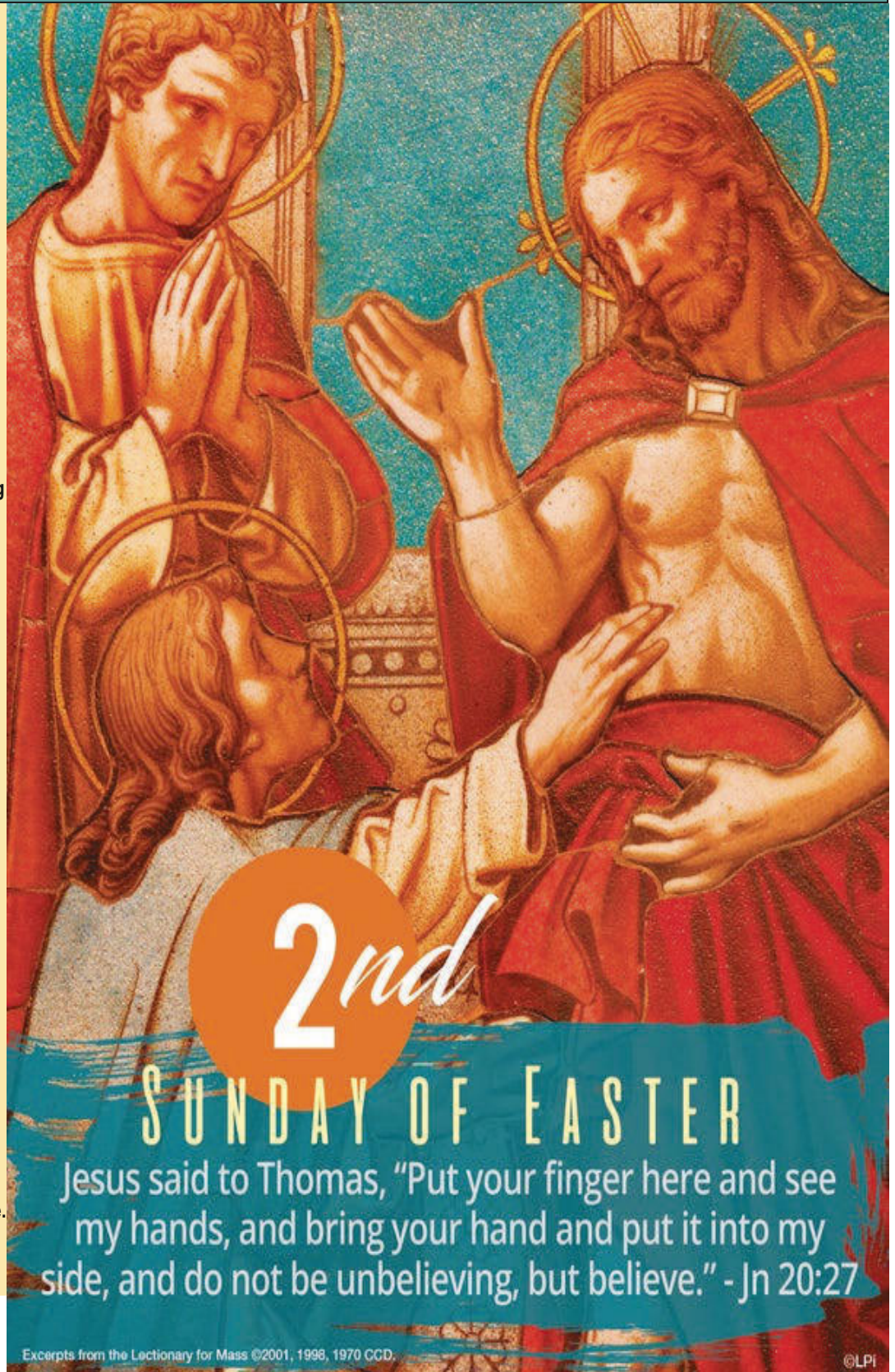

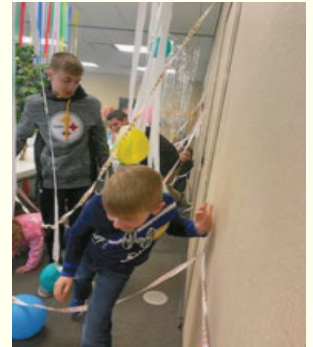

REFLECT ON TODAY'S READINGS

FIRST READING ACTS 5:12-16

Luke tells us of the success and healing power of the apostles in the Jerusalem church in the early days, weeks, and months following Jesus' resurrection. Where do you see this level of enthusiasm for the faith today?

SECOND READING REV 1:9-13, 17-19

The resurrected Jesus appears to John on the island of Patmos during his exile for bearing witness to the faith. In this encounter, John is initially fearful but then reassured by Jesus. When have you turned to Jesus in the moments of fear in your life?

GOSPEL READING JN 20:19-31

The apostle Thomas challenges his fellow apostles about the reality of Jesus' resurrection, seeking direct evidence from Jesus himself. How often do you encounter fellow believers who are skeptical in their faith?

All employees and volunteers working/serving for the Diocese of Erie, in our parishes, schools or agencies are mandated reporters both legally and morally obligated to report any reasonable suspected or known child abuse to ChildLine, the local police, or other appropriate agency.
