



### News Release from the Diocese of Erie

A word about confessing a crime to a priest...

"A priest can never reveal what is confessed to him in the sacrament of penance to anyone, for any reason, ever," according to Msgr. Edward Lohse, vicar general for the Diocese of Erie. "Understandably, a priest in confession would strongly encourage and even urge a person to come forward to authorities if a crime has been committed. But he cannot require the individual to do so."

Recently, an individual admitted his criminal actions to a priest in the Diocese of Erie, but it is important to clarify that this **did not** occur during sacramental confession. According to Msgr. Lohse "The individual admitted his actions to the priest outside of sacramental confession. (The priest) did what a priest does. He responded to someone who reached out to him in need."
