

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic disruptions, special collections have not been taken up in parishes in the Diocese of Erie for several months. The Peter's Pence Collection originally scheduled for this weekend has been moved to October 3 & 4. You will not need to use your envelopes for the "National Needs" or the "Church in Latin America" collections, scheduled in July and August 2020, from your packet at this time. The parish will forward any monies from envelopes we do collect to the Diocese. Parishes are asked to resume taking up special collections with the Sept. 20 Catholic Education Collection.

RETURN TO PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF WEEKEND MASSES HERE AT ALL SAINTS PARISH —NEXT WEEKEND, JULY 4 & 5, 2020

***PLEASE make a reservation for the Mass you plan to attend EACH WEEK. Call or email the parish office on Mon., Tues., and Thurs. mornings. (The parish office is closed on Wednesdays and will be closed on Friday, July 3rd for the 4th of July Holiday.) OR you may reserve your spot by using the Sign-Up links on myParish App or the parish website. Our seating capacity with social distancing is 90 people including families. If reservations are less than 90 there may be spots for people in the church, but taking that chance may mean you cannot come in. At that point you could be directed to watch the livestream of Mass on your mobile device in the parking lot. If that is the case, Communion MAY be distributed in the driving circle in front of the church after Mass is over. Announcements will be made on the website, Facebook, and myParish App on Fridays with the status of available space in the church.

You must wear a facemask. You will not be permitted to enter the church without one.

There will be no hymnals in the pews. My Parish App has the order of Mass and readings—you will be able to use your phone or tablet to follow the Mass. Do put them on silent mode. Or you may bring your own prayer book to use.

There will be no traditional offertory collection. You may drop your envelope in the basket located on the stand as you enter or exit the worship space. Online giving is a great option!

The practice will be to go straight to and from your cars and not congregate in the gathering space or parking lot before or after Mass. SCRIP cards will be available for purchase-Social distancing will be in effect for the purchase line.

Bishop Persico has announced that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Masses remains in effect. If you are not comfortable in returning at this time it is understandable and no problem at all.

And may God continue to BLESS each one of us in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit!
