All women of the parish are invited to join this newly formed women's group. The focus and direction of the group is being formulated and discussed and your ideas and creativity are welcomed at this next meeting.

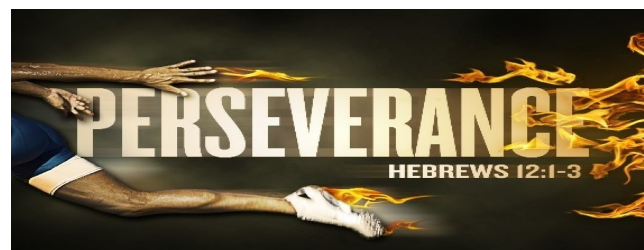
