Please be sensitive to others who choose not to shake hands during the Sign of Peace. Please do remember, if you are experiencing a cold or respiratory system problems, you should refrain from receiving the Precious Blood from the Cup. Eucharistic Ministers are reminded to follow the practice of sanitizing their hands before communion.
