Karen Phelps, a long distance runner,  
wrote these words:

*“On this particular day, I didn’t feel like running at all, but I made myself because running is a sport you have to practice every day. I wanted to win races, so I had to set a plan for training.*

- 1. Run daily, even if you don’t feel like it.*
- 2. Run daily, even if you sometimes have to skip fun and pleasure.*
- 3. Run daily, even in bad weather – even if people think you’re weird.*
