### ***FROM THE DESK OF DEACON JERRY***

**The Joy of the Resurrection!** ... The Gospel of Matthew, which is read at the Easter Vigil gives us the account of the women going to the tomb. Once there, they witness extraordinary and frightening events – an earthquake; an angel appearing *like lightning*; the guards, *shaken with fear who became like dead men*; and the body of Jesus missing. The angel tells them, *Do not be afraid! ... for [Jesus] has been raised just as he said*. Then he directs them to go quickly to tell Jesus’ disciples. The women run off, both *fearful* and *overjoyed*. During these times you could say we are experiencing similar feelings as our daily lives and routines have been tossed into turmoil amid constant fear and doubt. Whatever fear and doubt Mary Magdalene and the other Mary had after encountering the angel, was erased when they encountered Jesus himself. While we cannot worship together on this most holy day of the year, we can still have an encounter with Jesus himself. He is not a ghost or a memory – he is very much alive and present to us and as we worship him, we are reassured by his words, *Do not be afraid*. For today we do not merely *recall* what happened two thousand years ago on a cross and in a humble rock-hewn tomb, we *participate* in this continuing sacrificial mystery. We rejoice that Jesus suffered, died and rose *for us*. We rejoice because his sacrifice was once, *for all*. Today, we rejoice because he *continues* to save his people. Our risen Lord is here among us. Just like Jesus we too will triumph over suffering, sorrow, anguish, and death and rise to new life. Believe it! Our legacy as Christians, as people who have encountered Jesus, is to be witnesses to the Resurrection. Each one of us is called to cultivate hope in our hearts and to bring the joy and hope of the Resurrection to those who most desperately need it whether it is a health care worker, first responder, family member, or anyone who feels weighed down by the current circumstances or just life in general. Today we remember that we never walk alone. Just as Jesus met the women rushing back to the Apostles, so does Jesus meet us along the way of our current journey and keep us company.

Our challenge this Easter remains the same – it never changes. Our challenge is to live as people of the Resurrection, as people of love, promise joy, and hope. He is risen – alleluia!  
May each of you feel the love, hope, peace, and mercy of our Risen Lord. Happy Easter!
