FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Welcome Everyone as we celebrate the Mass for the Fifth Sunday of Lent, Passion Sunday in the old Latin Rite.—Until further notice the obligation to attend Sunday Mass (or Saturday afternoon) has been dispensed for the faithful in the Diocese of Erie due to the Coronavirus pandemic. All public Masses have been cancelled, Saturday/Sunday and weekday Masses included. The priests will continue to offer the Masses privately. †Remember the following Lenten Regulations: 1)

Lenten practices of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving and other forms of self-denial are recommended most warmly by the Church. Daily Mass (when available) is particularly encouraged. Our weekday Masses (*when we are able to continue them*) are Monday through Friday at 8AM at St. Casimir's and 12:05PM at St. Ann's when possible. Confessions before and after Mass at St. Ann's when possible. 2). Good Friday is a day of abstinence from eating meat for those 14 years of age and older. 3) Good Friday is also a day of fasting for those ages 18 to 58 inclusive. On this day those bound by the law of fasting may take one full meal and two smaller meals sufficient to maintain strength. Eating between meals is not permitted but milk and fruit juices are allowed. Where health or work is affected, the law does not apply. We hope you make a good Lent! †A special schedule will be published for Holy Week, please stay tuned! †Continue to remember **Father Dan Prez** in your prayers. As you know **Father Dan** has some serious medical problems and needs prayers. Thank you for all you have done for **Father Dan** in past weeks and we will keep you posted. †Congratulations and Best Wishes to the officers and members of the Slovak National Club. †The 2020 CSA appeal began on Sunday, February 23rd.
