### FROM THE DESK OF DEACON JERRY

#### **St. Michael the Archangel Pray for Us**

The stunning statue of St. Michael the Archangel has been in place for a few weeks now and I hope you have had a chance to see it up close and meditate and pray to St. Michael. We were able to get this statue through the efforts of a very special person who wishes to remain anonymous.

According to spiritual tradition, Michael is the chief of the celestial armies and the protector of the Church (Revelation 12:7-9). While there are various accounts regarding the origin of the St. Michael prayer, one thing is certain: Pope Leo XIII was observed staring at something invisible or unknown while celebrating Mass. Immediately after, he went into his private office and wrote the St. Michael Prayer. According to his private secretary Pope Leo XIII received a vision in which he saw Satan tell God that he would destroy the Church over time.

This shook him so much that the prayer was mandated as part of every Low Mass celebrated between 1886 to 1964. For that matter it is still recited at the conclusion of every Latin Low Mass. Recently the St. Michael Prayer has been reinstated into many masses throughout the world and plans are to occasionally reintroduce it here at Our Mother of Sorrows.

As we enter October and rapidly approach the new church year may we continue to pray to St. Michael the Archangel for protection for the Church and also for each of us.
