

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Today our Gospel presents us with the story of the transfiguration of Jesus. We hear God say, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." Because of our baptism, we share in the same intimate relationship with the Father that Jesus has. This intimate relationship we have with God can transform us, just as it transformed Jesus. We, too, can radiate with love and newness of life and then help in transforming and positively impacting the lives of others. How has your relationship with God transformed you?



Last week, I introduced The Melchizedek Project,

an ongoing program of support and encouragement, for our young people, who feel called to the priesthood, or religious life. We will be implementing this Project over the next few weeks and months, in conjunction with the Office of Vocations of the Diocese of Erie, and Father Michael Polinek, the Vocation Director. OLQA will host St. Andrew's Dinners for young men, discerning the will of God, and St. Miriam Dinners for young women, who

are discerning God's will in their lives. The Lord reminds us that "The Harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." He commends us also to "pray to the Lord of the Harvest to send workers into the harvest." At OLQA, we are faithfully praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Bishop Persico has thanked us for doing this, and he asks that we work very hard to develop a "culture of vocations," in the parish, and among our families, and friends. 




It's almost back to school time! At the Masses on Aug 26 & 27 there will be a special blessing of all school-aged children
