Influenza, the H1N1 Virus and the Liturgy General Guidelines for the Diocese of Erie, From the Office of Worship



All Liturgical Ministers (including clergy):

- Wash hands prior to, and after, Mass.

Furthermore, for All Those Distributing Communion:

- After exchanging the Sign of Peace briefly, prepare to distribute Communion.
- Extraordinary ministers should use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer (discreetly please, i.e., not in the sanctuary if at all possible) before & after distributing communion.
- Avoid physically touching those coming forward in the communion line, whether they are receiving on the hand, or on the tongue, or asking for a blessing.
- Follow all standard procedures for ministering the cup after each communicant has received:
- Pinch and wipe thoroughly the rim with the purificator.
- Rotate the cup one quarter turn after each communicant receives.
- Regularly re-position the purificator to a clean section as you are using it.
