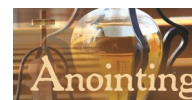

Council Chatter: When should you sit after communion?

Each Bishop decides whether Catholics in his Diocese kneel or stand during Communion. By Decree of the Bishop of Erie, Catholics must stand during Communion from *The Our Father*, **until the last person receives Communion, then they sit**

Many of our Summer parishioners and visitors kneel from *Behold the Lamb of God*, until the Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle, after Communion, then they sit, because that is the practice in their own Diocese.

Therefore, some Catholics are standing, while others are kneeling. A reminder to all: The local Bishop decides on posture during Mass, while urging due respect for the Real Presence, in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar.
