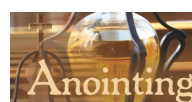

BISHOP PERSICO'S LITURGIES DURING HOLY WEEK

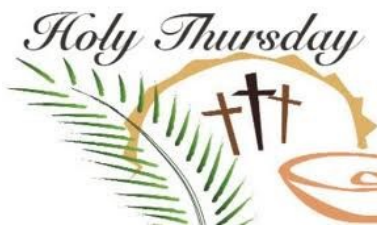
