

### From Father David...

AS I mentioned at Masses last weekend, our Fire and Security upgrades are well under way. We have partnered with Guardian Protective Services to provide and monitor fire safety and security throughout the building. The work began in the PEC and the rectory over the past two



weeks, and will continue in the Hall and the Child Care Center. Fire Alarm systems and lighted exit signs have been installed along with video security at three of the entrances .

One aspect of the upgrade to security, is the installation of keypads at three, designated entry doors. IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE A KEY, AND ARE DESIGNATED TO HAVE A KEY TO OLQA, you must use the designated doors, and have your own password to the keypad. Please call in to the office, and arrange for a key to one of these designated doors, and to arrange for your password. Once fully activated, our system will alert the police to any, unauthorized entry; doors to the Church and Hall will be open during the regular, weekend hours, and will not be alarmed, during those times. Thanks for your cooperation as we make our Church safe for everyone.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments Child Abuse Prevention Month: What Happens When Abuse is Reported?

People who hold positions of trust in Catholic institutions are mandated by Pennsylvania law to report child abuse. Teachers, teacher's aides, and counselors in our schools; therapists and social workers in our counseling agencies; clergy, parish employees, and volunteers in schools and parishes all have the obligation to report the reasonable suspicion of child abuse to ChildLine, the local police, or other appropriate agency.
