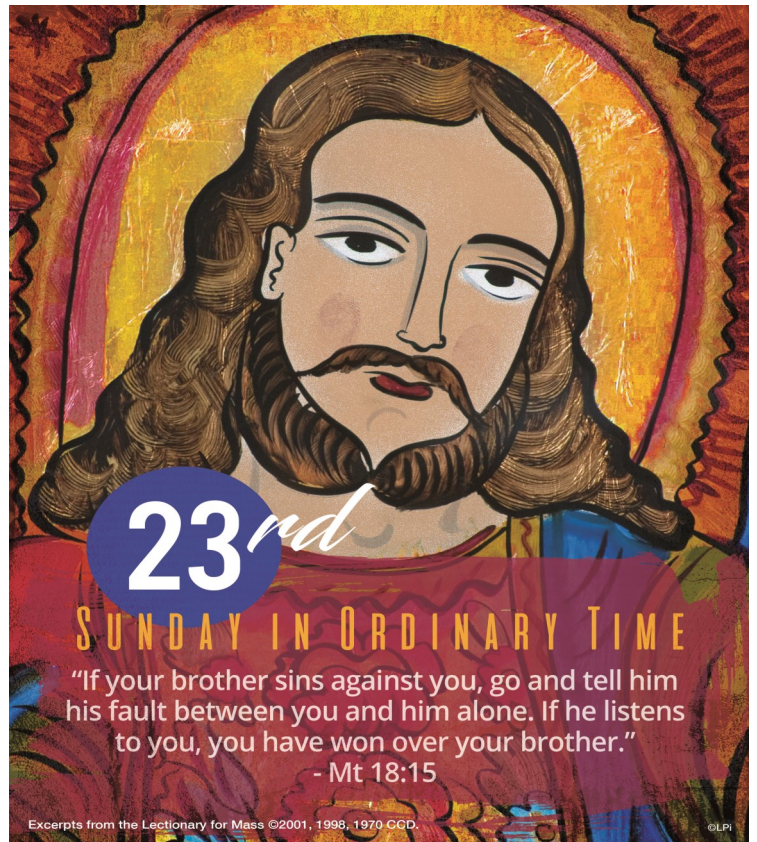

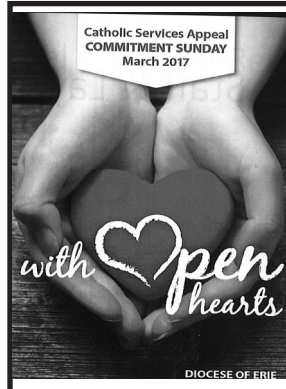

“Jesus my Lord, I Thee adore, O make me love Thee more and more!”

At OLQA, we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Monday through Friday, from 6:30 a.m., until we have Benediction at 7:50 a.m. Eucharistic Adoration is part of the rich, liturgical and spiritual Tradition of the Catholic Church, and it has been especially recommended by Bishop Persico, to help build the Culture of Vocations, in the Diocese of Erie. Everyone is welcome; and we especially invite all the children of the parish to come and spend a few minutes before morning classes, in quiet prayer with our Lord.

While it has been the practice of the parish to have “First Friday” and “First Monday” Adoration from 8-11:30 a.m., **we will replace these monthly events with our new Adoration schedule.** (First Friday, and First Saturday “Prayers of Reparation,” may still be recited by individuals, privately. Confessions are heard every Saturday, from 3:30-4:30 p.m., and at any time, by request). I will be taking Communion to the Homebound, and to those in Nursing homes on Thursday, prior to First Friday, so that I may begin a day off on Friday, after morning Mass.

As Catholics, it is important for us to be open to the Real Presence of our Lord in our lives. What better way to encounter him, than to “watch and pray with him” in his Eucharistic Heart? And what better way to feed the Soul of our parish than for all of you to spend time with the Lord, in prayer, before the Blessed Sacrament. Throughout the coming year, there will be other times when opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration will be offered, as those occasions present themselves. With our hearts centered on the Lord, how can we fail?
