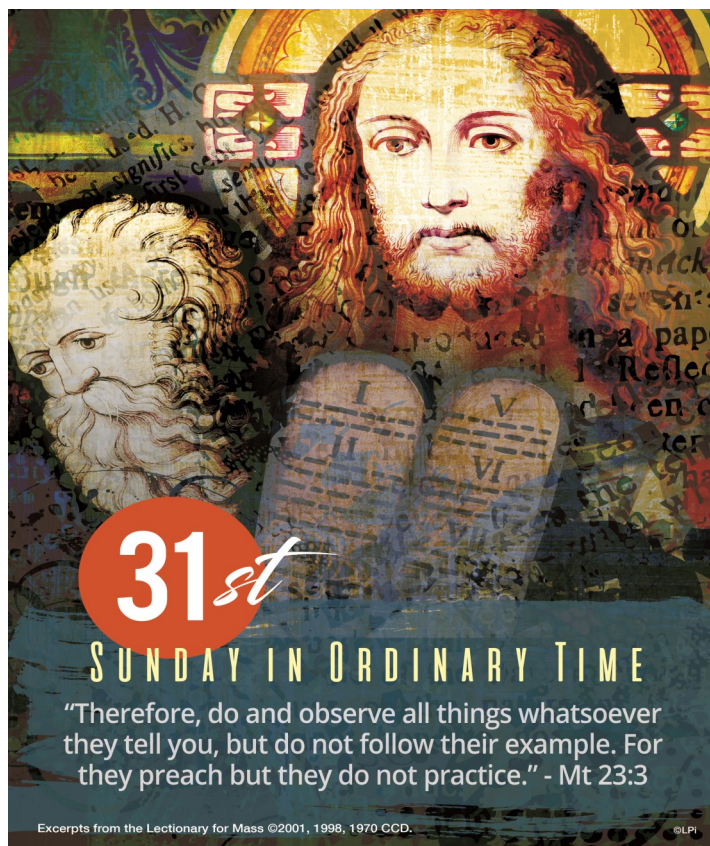

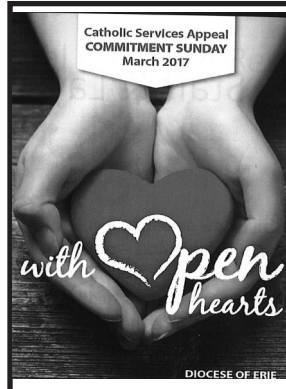

**Online Safety Tips for

Even the most trusted adults can't always be trusted. Coaches, teacher and parents are authority figures children feel they can trust. Yet, a large percentage of those who sexually abuse children come from this group. These are adults who have the opportunity to 'groom' children with affection and attention, making it difficult for children to identify certain attention as abuse. And they know that children have been taught to 'mind' them. Adults must be vigilant and trained to recognize 'red flags' of predatory behavior.
