



CHRISTMAS GREETINGS FROM YOUR PRIEST

"HOW SILENTLY, HOW SILENTLY THE WONDROUS GIFT IS GIVEN! SO GOD IMPARTS TO HUMAN HEARTS THE BLESS-INGS OF HIS HEAVEN. NO EAR CAN HEAR HIS COMING, YET IN THIS WORLD OF SIN, WHERE MEEK SOULS WILL RECEIVE HIM STILL, THE DEAR CHRIST ENTERS IN."

Written by Rev. Phillips Brooks, in 1868, these words speak of the "silent coming' of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Father Brooks had just returned from a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, and he was inspired to write this poem that we know as the hymn, "O Little Town of Bethlehem."

We are called during this Advent Season to prepare our hearts and minds for the coming of the Lord.


We are called to watch for his coming, and to wait in expectation, as parents await the arrival of a newborn baby. We are called to wait, with hope, and love, as Mary and Joseph did, in that "Little Town," so long ago.


May the dear Christ enter your hearts at Christmas, and remain with you forever. Amen.
