Commitment Sunday for the 2018 Catholic Services Appeal will be February 11th. The theme for the CSA this year is "United in Service". As a diocese, let us offer to those who are in need the services which no single parish can afford. Please pray for a successful 2018 Appeal. Last year's CSA provided our parish with \$20,000 in funds that are dedicated to repairs of the floors in Anderson Hall. After my arrival in the Summer, a tour of our facilities brought to light some fire, lighting, and safety issues that needed to be addressed, so I thought it prudent to put our Anderson Hall project on hold until these were addressed. I am happy to report that these issues are being addressed, and that we can get back to the Hall Project, which will rely on your generous support of the CSA. (I will be able to provide more information on Anderson Hall upgrades after working with a Special Committee that I have discussed with the Parish Council).
