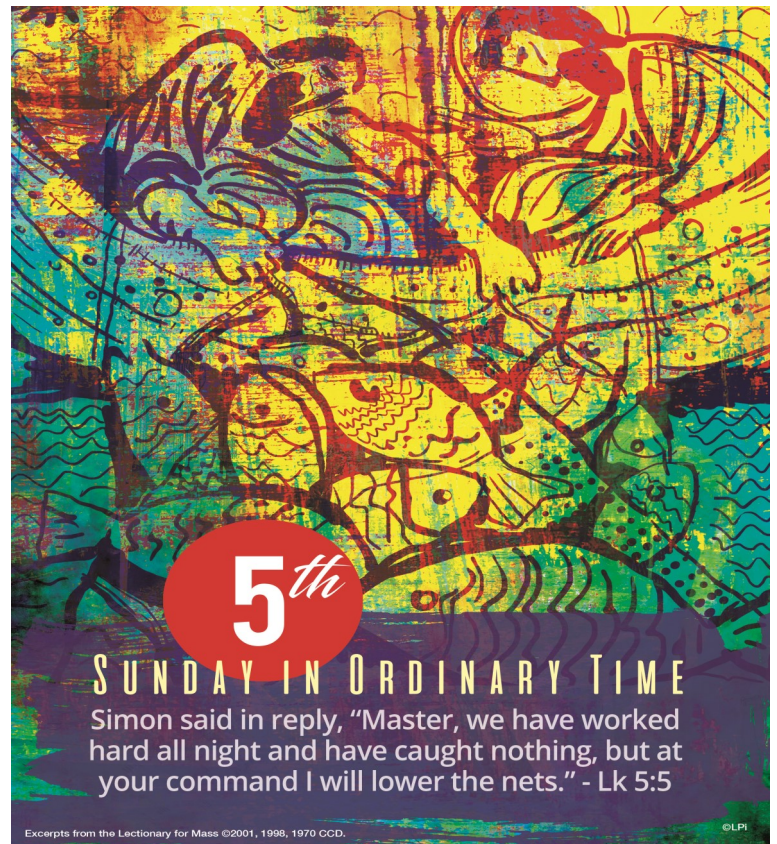



NEW ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM
We are in the early phases of developing an **adult education program on the Mass.** Our goal is to have all our parishioners enter more fully into the Mystery of the Mass, as they encounter the Living God in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and in their lives. This program will be a continuation of the Morning of Reflection that we had last Fall, with Father Cyprian Constantine, OSB.
