

QUO VADIS DAYS

The Diocese of Erie and the Diocese of Greensburg are teaming up for their first annual **Quo Vadis Days (QVD)** at St. Philip Church and Retreat Center in Linesville **July 8-11**. This retreat/camp is designed for high school boys who are considering seminary formation and the priesthood, and who are striving to follow God's call in their lives. Erie Bishop Lawrence T. Persico and Greensburg Bishop Edward C. Malesic will celebrate Masses. Other visiting priests will give talks and seminarians will be on hand throughout the week. **"Quo Vadis" is the Latin phrase for "Where are you going?"** The legend is that St. Peter was fleeing the persecution of Nero and leaving Rome, when he saw Jesus heading into Rome. Peter asks Jesus, **"Lord, where are you going?"** Jesus responds, **"To Rome to be crucified."** Then Jesus disappeared. At that moment Peter headed back into Rome to face martyrdom.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments
Dangers of Cell Phone Cameras: Cell phone cameras are a mixed blessing. Forget your camera? Whip out the cell phone, and your toddler's first step, friend's goofy mishap, or fender-bender is captured for posterity. But cell phones are also being used in a sinister way – to silently take pictures of unsuspecting children, adolescents, and adults in compromising positions and without their consent. Plus, digital photos can be placed on the internet very quickly – within minutes of taking the photo – and distributed around the world. In fact, some web sites have been created for the sole purpose of posting photos taken surreptitiously with camera phones. Be aware of anyone using a cell phone in an awkward way, such as not holding it up to his or her ear or facing his or her mouth in a walkie-talkie style. Be especially cognizant of any suspicious cell phone use in areas where people could be in various stages of undress or where children are gathered. If you see someone using a cell phone in a way that appears suspicious, don't be afraid to ask what he or she is doing or to alert someone in a position of authority about your concerns.
