Sister Parish - Antorcha

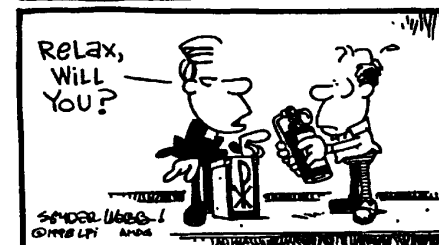
