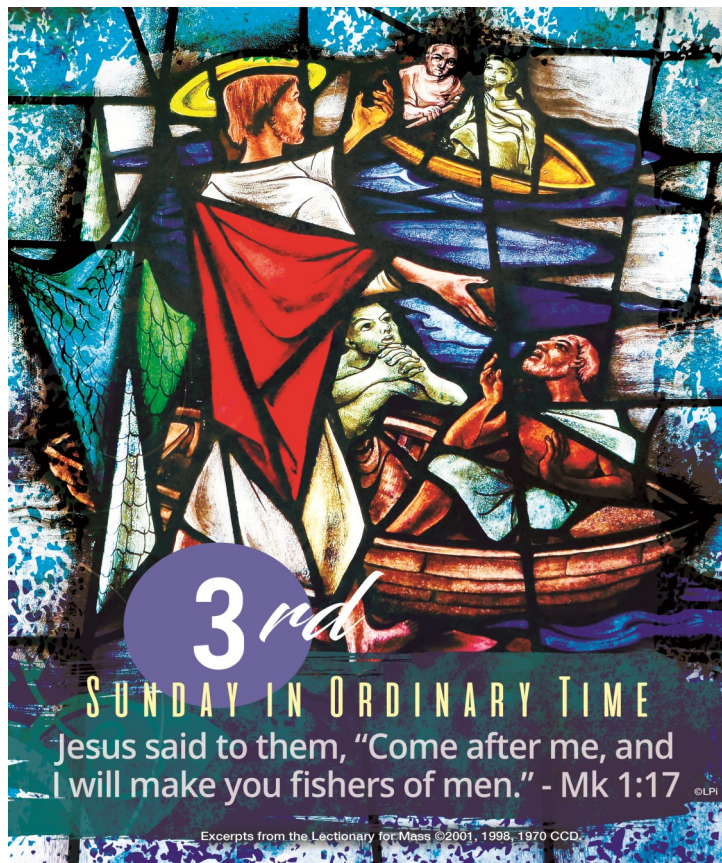

I would like to remind all of you of the clear teaching of the Church that “the whole Christ, Body and Blood, Soul, and Divinity, is received under **either** the species of Bread **or** Wine”, and that it is **never necessary for the Faithful to receive both species to receive Christ in the Holy Communion.** I will revisit the distribution of the Precious Blood, after the Flu Season abates.

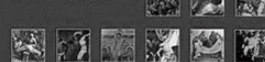
