



SISTER PARISH CORNER— **New Initiatives Announced!**

Correspondence Initiative: Our Religious Ed students have written letters to the students of St. Isidore, and a few of our families are writing to the "women who do everything" at St. Isidore Parish in Ochil, Yucatan. The first batch of about 40 letters went to Mexico by courier this week. After a couple of months, we expect to receive answers to these letters. The Amistad Mission in Merida, a branch of the Erie Diocese, is managing the translation and delivery of the letters. We believe through this "pen pal" contact, we may form lasting friendships with the people of Ochil. If you are interested in becoming a pen pal, talk to Bill or Pat Pineo.
